BLENDED LEARNING DELIVERY IS NOW AVAILABLE

What is a blended learning first aid course?

Blended learning is a combination of **in-class** instruction with online instruction.

Theory and information are conveyed to participants through an online component. This allows for the in-class component to concentrate on skill development and the application of theory. This course is WSIB approved and instruction standards remain the same.

STEP 1 ONLINE COMPONENT



- Participants receive online access to the Blended Learning Portion from the Canadian Red Cross after registration with Front Line Services.
- Learn the theory and knowledge with interactive activities completed at your own pace.
- Accessible on all devices.
- During COVID restrictions a TEMPORARY completion of online certification will be issued. This is now temporarily acceptable with WSIB, until in-class sessions can resume.

STEP 2 IN-CLASS SESSION



- Participants complete the classroom session after completing the online component.
- Taught by a Canadian Red Cross Blended Learning Instructor.
- Practice and demonstrate the hands-on skills and techniques.
- In-Class Session must be taken within 6 weeks of the Online Course
- During COVID restrictions this 6 week window has been extended to 90 days based on social distancing guidelines.

STEP 3 RECEIVE CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION



Receive Canadian Red Cross certification upon completion of In-Class Session and knowledge evaluation.
